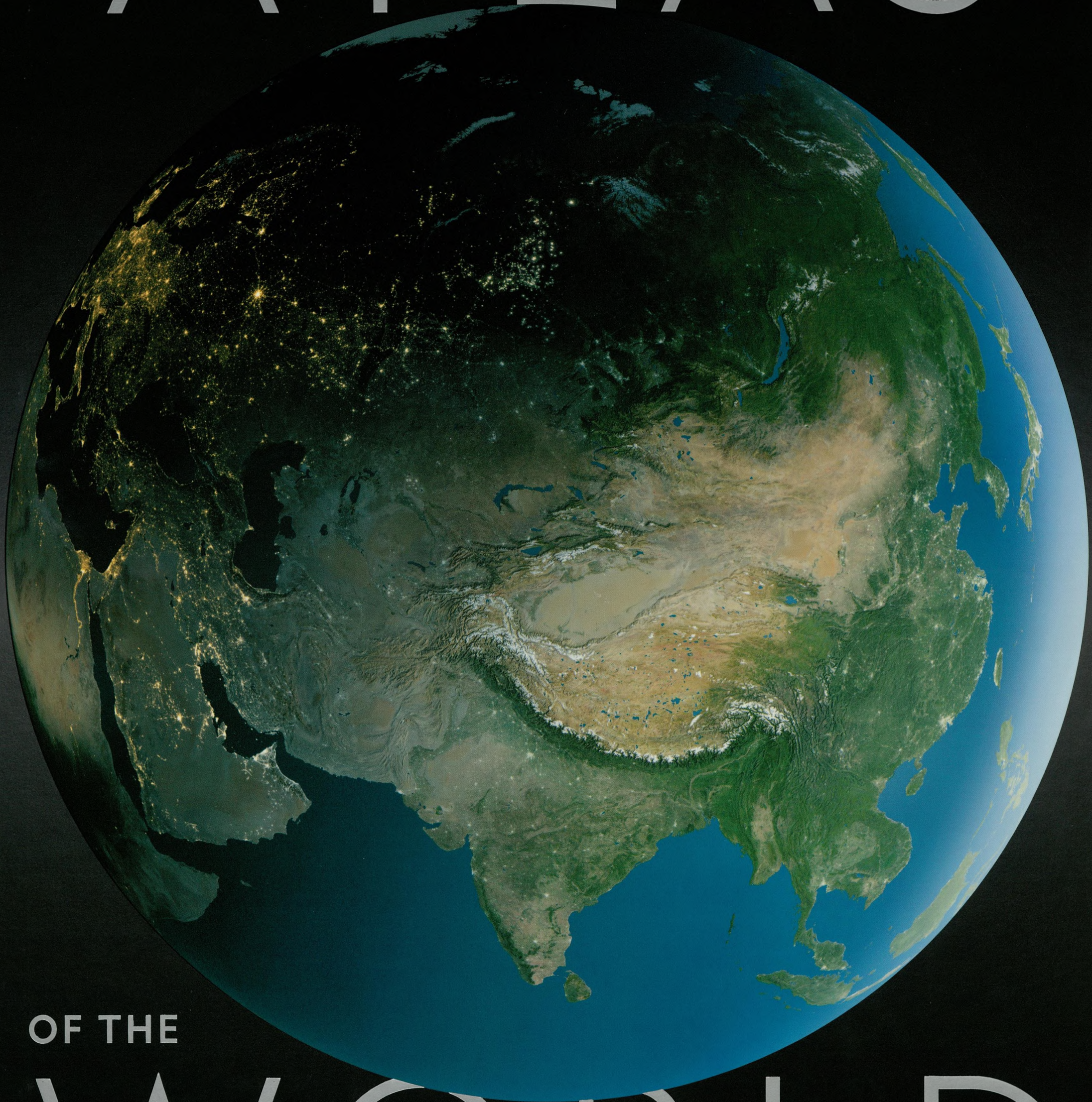

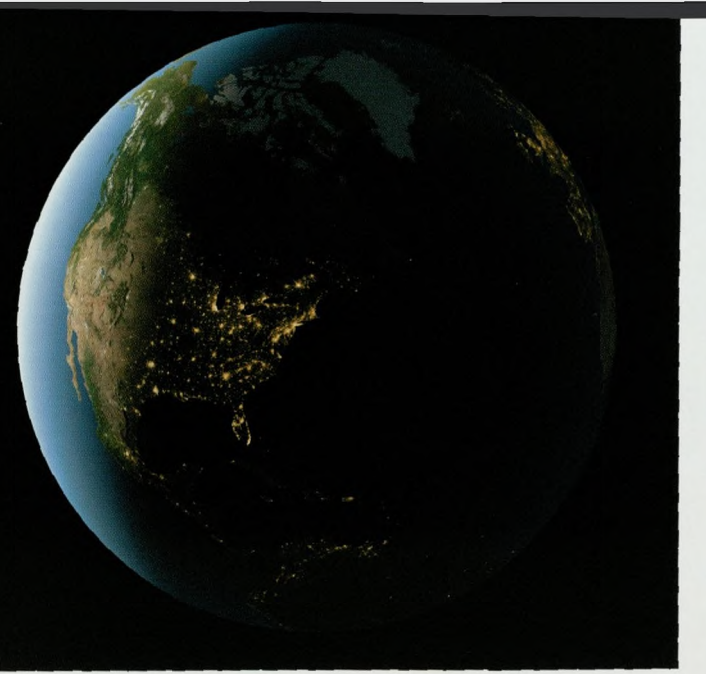

- 6 **TECTONICS: EARTH'S SHAPES & STRUCTURES**
Plate boundaries, earthquakes, volcanoes, and hot spots; Pangaea and Pangaea Proxima; tectonic processes
- 7 **CLIMATE: SHIFTING WEATHER PATTERNS**
Climate zones; temperature and precipitation; storm tracks; lightning strikes; extreme climate risk
- 8 **CLIMATE CHANGE: LIFE ON A WARMING PLANET**

Anthromes or human-altered biomes and human impact on oceans; human footprint—past and present; plastic production and pollution
- 14 **POPULATION: EVER MORE CROWDED PLANET**
Population density; projected most populous countries; aging population; projected global population; gender disparity; population pyramids
- 15 **URBANIZATION: AS MORE CITIES EXPAND**
Percentage of population living in urban areas; changes in urbanization; dominant cities; travel time to major cities; increase in megacities
- 16 **CULTURES: GLOBAL CULTURAL DIVERSITY**
Indigenous languages location and level of endangerment; major language families; dominant languages; dominant religion; second largest religious groups
- 17 **HUMAN RIGHTS: TRACKING CIVIL FREEDOMS**
Human Rights Index; child labor; Corruption Perception Index; freedom of the press; rights of women and girls, human rights since World War II; LGBT legal rights
- 18 **HUMAN CONDITION: GAUGING QUALITY OF LIFE**
Human Development Index; school enrollment; extreme poverty; global literacy; Happiness Index
- 19 **HEALTH: SEEKING WORLD WELLNESS**
Burden of communicable and noncommunicable diseases; change in mortality rate; obesity; causes of death; mental health disability
- 20 **AGRICULTURE: FEEDING A GROWING WORLD**
Where crops are grown; sustainable agriculture; global fisheries; Food Security Index; diets around the world
- 21 **BORDERS: LINES DRAWN ON THE MAP**
Boundary disputes and unilateral claims; treatment of Crimea on maps; maritime boundaries; maritime limits; South China Sea
- 22 **MIGRATION: MAKING A HOME ELSEWHERE**
UNHCR People of Concern and immigrants; Syrian IDPs and refugees; European immigrants; climate change migration; migrants as a percent of population; tracking remittances
- 23 **ECONOMY: WORLD WEALTH FACTORS**
GDP per capita; income gaps; urban-rural disparities; public and private economy; largest trade players; concentration of wealth; shadow economies
- 24 **ENERGY: CHANGING POWER SOURCES**
Consumption of fossil and nonfossil fuels; crude oil reserves; wind power potential; nuclear generating capacity; bioenergy
- 25 **GLOBAL CONNECTIVITY: LINKING ALL THE WORLD**
Access to the internet and government restrictions; tracking cybercrime; communications satellites; undersea telecommunications cables; Google search market share
